A Note from the Teacher

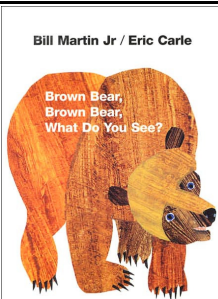


Dear Parents,
