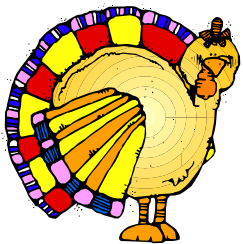
A Peek at the Week

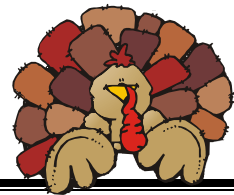
Mr. Turkey
