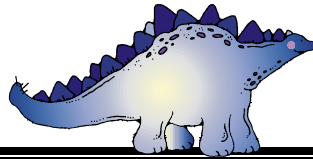

A Peek at the Week

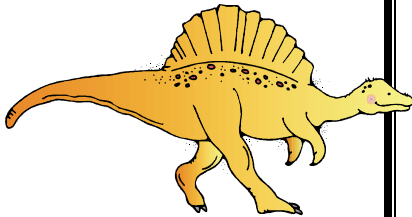

G-R-E-E-N

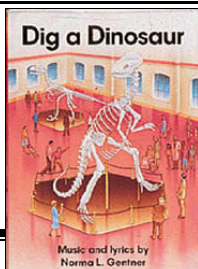
A Note from the Teacher
