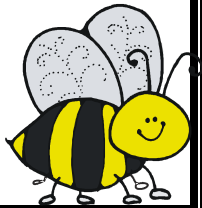

Can your nose do half as well?

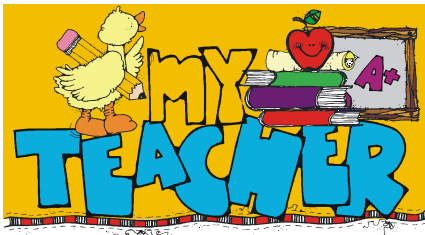
Also you'd be in a fix
